

Good morning and welcome to everyone who has joined us at St. Ninian's this morning. We hope you will enjoy our worship of God together today. As a congregation our mission is to 'Worship God together, encourage personal faith and prayer, spread the Good News about Jesus Christ, and love and care for others in our community.' If you are a visitor, there is a visitors' book at the front door, please sign it.

Before the service there is weekly a **Prayer Group** that meets in Room 6 (the Alpha Room) from 10:00am – 10:15am. Everyone is welcome, please ask a steward for Room 6 Alpha Room.

For preschool children there is a **crèche** and for primary aged children there is a **Sunday School** this morning. *Alpha*, St. Ninian's Sunday School for children in secondary school meets on the first Sunday of the month. Children should leave for Sunday School after the second hymn.

The reader this morning is **Sarah Aitken**. The organist is **Anne Kirkpatrick**. Leading worship is the **Rev. James Aitken**.

This morning we **celebrate and dedicate the members and work of St. Ninian's Guild.** Nationally the strategy for the Church of Scotland Guild, 2024 - 2026, is: Let us Build a House; and 2024's theme in particular is: Sure Foundations. St. Ninian's Guild welcomes everyone – men and women. It meets on Tuesdays at 2:15pm for friendship, fellowship, talks and tea and coffee. The first meeting of the Guild for this session is on the 1st of October.

Following worship there is fellowship, friendship, and refreshments in the Martin Shields' Hall. Please join us.

St. Ninian's uses the Revised Common Lectionary which is an approved week-by-week three-year cycle of biblical readings. In 2024 we are in Year B and the principal Gospel readings come from the **Gospel of Mark**. The readings lead us from Advent through the Christian year, the Bible, and Jesus' life through birth, baptism, his public ministry, his death, resurrection and ascension.

ENTRANCE

The service begins with a **sentence from the Bible** (1 Cor 16: 13. 14), a **call to stand** (please do so if you are able to), an **introit** from the choir, and the **entrance of the Bible**. For the rest of the service the words in bold are read or sung by everyone. We sit to pray and stand to sing.

WELCOME, INTIMATIONS and SHARING OF THE PEACE We welcome one another with Christ's words 'Peace be with you'.

CALL TO WORSHIP
